Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We sincerely apologize for the lateness in sending out this prayer letter.

So much has been happening here over the last few months, and we are so excited to see God working in the hearts and lives of the people here in Pomerode. It has now been 7 months since we held our first service. For the first few weeks after we opened, we prayed for people to come to church, passed out tracts, and invited people to church, but it was mostly just our two families for services. Then one Sunday night after the services had ended, a lady walked in and wanted to talk to the pastor. We sat down and listened to her story, shared scripture, counseled her, and shared the gospel. Little did we know that through her, God would bring a group of people to our church. God worked in her life and she started coming faithfully. She began bringing her daughter, and after a little bit her niece came, and then a sister and brother-in-law. At this point, there are about 10 people regularly attending as a direct result of her inviting them to come.

A young man named Francois works at a shop near our house. We befriended him and found out that he is a language teacher. He began tutoring the boys in Portuguese, and then said he would come to our first service. He now attends regularly on Sunday mornings, and has begun bringing his girlfriend, her sister, and her mother. Please pray for their salvation. We also ask you to pray for another young man named Lucas. He has been coming regularly, but at this time we believe him to be unsaved as well.

October through the beginning of December we had a kids club at church on Saturdays. Zack and Stephanie Gerwitz led the program which consisted of songs, memory verses, games, snacks and most importantly a Bible lesson. It was a blessing to see the kids excited, and we average around 10-15 kids a week! We are hoping to start the club back up again soon.

I was able to be part of a service for the drug rehabilitation center here in town. During the service, I was able to present the gospel and had 4 come forward during the invitation. After that service, the center allowed those who were interested to come to our Sunday morning and evening services. For a little over a month, we had between 4-7 of the guys coming.

During the month of December, we had the privilege of having a Christmas lunch with quite a few people. For our Christmas night service, we had 43 people in attendance, and for our New Years' Eve service we had 41 people.

We have been able to begin several one-on-one Bible studies with some of the people coming. Please pray for the salvation of those who are not saved and for the spiritual growth of those who are.
