We are thankful for each and every one of you and can't say thank you enough for your prayers and support all these years.

Here are some highlights and prayer requests since our last update:

- Our children's ministry has been going fantastic. Our history in ministry hinges on the children's ministry, as my wife and I were saved because of an outreach to young people. Recently, we were able to take our faithful children (who memorized Scripture and attended faithfully for several weeks continually) to an outing. It was a blessing to be able to challenge them on the topic of being a profitable child of God.

- God has been blessing our village ministries greatly. It's a joy to see our folks grow and continue to be faithful to Him. I was able to go preach in a village church plant this past November, and it was exciting to see their love and fervor for the Lord. It was also an

added blessing to be able to go with my daughter and have her help teach the children while I preach in the main service.

- I am thankful for faithful men who God brings our way to teach and train. It's been a joy to teach Chhay and his wife, Tuesday mornings. It been awesome to see their spiritual growth and their desire to rear up their children for God's glory. On Wednesdays, I also have discipleship and accountability time with 6 other men (two former Cham Muslims, two Kouys-indigenous ethnic minority, and two Khmers).
- Please continue to **pray for the men in our ministry** as we strive to reach, teach, and train godly men for the glory of God.
- Pray for a young girl in one of the village ministries, name **Julie**. She is a niece of one of our faithful men, Vichet, who has been praying for his family to come to Christ despite of him being persecuted by them. Julie has a cancerous cyst on her neck and the mom has been sensitive to God during this trying time. Pray that God would use this trial to bring the mom to God's saving grace.
- Pray for these **prospects** that we have been working on for salvation. They are also part of an indigenous ethnic minority group of people here in Cambodia--**Yem, Houn, Duen, Phon, Srey Mao, Srey Pring, & Romchek**.



My daughter and Srey Mohm were able to tag team and minister to the children while I preach to the adults at our village church plant. Srey Mohm is a daughter of a notorious demon possessed maniac, now her father is a faithful Christian. The gospel changes lives! (Right) Auntie Nim just recently recovered from a horrific traffic accident. Regardless of her situations, she radiates with joy and brings encouragement to me every time I see her!

- Please also pray for our church's Friend Day this Sunday the 18th. Our folks have invited their friends and acquaintances and we are anticipating a packed service full of unsaved visitors. I have 10 people who have committed to come. Please pray for the Holy Spirit to use this grand opportunity for them to hear the gospel clearly and understand their need for Christ.
