We pray that we are able to do justice and convey God's goodness to us and our ministry in this update. Currently, we are on furlough up until November. Our family is excited to be able to see Titus, our oldest son, graduate and also take him to college. While stateside, we will tend to some health needs for our special needs daughter as well.

Here are some highlights and prayer requests since our last update:

- During the latter part of January, our church was able to organize a missions trip to the northwestern part of Cambodia, to the province of Battambang. 33 of our church members were able to go on a 3 day trip to reach family members of some of our church members who were open to the Gospel. **We were able to make contacts in a muslim village and other villages, and see a couple people accept Christ as Savior.**
- Brathana and Chantrea, a couple who I led to the Lord a couple months ago, were able to finish an assignment that was given to them and were so **excited to receive their own Bible**. The cost of a Bible is at least 10% of their monthly salary so they were so grateful to receive one each.
- Many of you prayed for our church's Friend Day back in December. We had an auditorium filled with visitors and guests. Many of whom were so taken back by the kindness and joyfulness that our members exhibited. The unsaved were so shocked to see and hear the testimonies of our members and it left a great impression on them. We are excited to follow up on these new contacts and visitors from that day. **As a result several have already gotten saved from this event.**
- **We were able to get to the US safely for furlough and God allowed us to spend quality time with family and friends.** It was also a blessing to be a part of English speaking services. God gave me the privilege to preach at our sending church's missions conference. It was also a blessing to be able to report to one of our partners in Central CA and share with them what the Lord is doing in Cambodia.
- Thank you for also praying for my friend, an assistant pastor at our home church, Charlie Chim. **He has been out of his coma**, recovered as well as he can, and I was able to hear him preach behind the pulpit again, a month ago.

- **God blessed us with a vehicle this past month** from an Iranian Christian to transport our family around. We were blessed and encouraged by the fellowship we had with him. We are so thankful for God's provisions.
- In March, we had a Missions Sunday/Celebration service and had over **30 people follow the Lord in believers' baptism**. It was also a blessing that our church was able to take on a new missionary family for monetary and prayer support as well.
- Please pray for the new folks that have been saved that they would continue to grow and be faithful to the Lord: **Somaly, David, Piseth, Srey Ya, and Thema.**
- Please pray for us as we seek wisdom, clarity, and direction on our **Christian school ministry**. We currently have an academy but want to take it up a step further and use it to invest in the next generation.
- Please pray for our family as we are on furlough and endeavor to accomplish some of our tasks and goals while we are here. **Please pray for Lara that she would get the necessary therapy she needs and for our son, Titus, as he prepares for college.**
