**FAMILY UPDATES:**

- January 6th was our 10th year anniversary serving here in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. Thank you for all the faithful years of prayer and support for our family! I am grateful that I got to celebrate another birthday this year and realize more than ever that our time is getting shorter and we must work the works of Him who sent us!
- Our two oldest boys are currently in the US attending Bible college. Titus started the second semester of his sophomore year, and Tyler has also started his second semester for his freshman year. We miss them being home here in Cambodia, but know they are where God wants them to be.



**MINISTRY UPDATES:**

- PACIFIC BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE OF PHNOM PENH**  
We are thrilled to have 5 of our Bible college students graduate. These 5 students are great servants of the Lord and 3 of them are currently in full-time ministry. We had the privilege to personally invest heavily in 2 of them, Makara and Veasna. Makara is a talented and godly young lady who loves the Lord and people. She is an avid soulwinner and hard worker. Veasna has been living with us since 2019 and is now married to his wife, Borey and has 2 sweet girls. He currently runs our children's ministry and oversees a village outreach 20 minutes away from our location. We were also able to start teaching college classes at one of our church plants an hour away. Every single one of these students has suffered persecution from family and village folks, but still endeavors to live for God's glory!

One of the highlights of our ministry is seeing small Bible studies become a church plant. This church plant in Preah Vihear province is a testament to God's greatness and faithfulness. We have seen the Kuy people, an ethnic minority here in Cambodia, turn from darkness into spiritual light. Roughly

60% of our membership there are Kuy. Thank God for the saving power of the Gospel!



**THE NEXT GENERATION**

God has blessed us with a great group of young people. The evidence of God working in their lives is seeing them faithfully displaying the 2 Timothy 2:2 principle. Any given day of the week, we see teenagers discipling other children from their routes at the church. They are busy making disciples and faithfully serving in various ministries. I am excited that my wife has also been teaching and discipling a group of teen girls on the subject of Christian womanhood and preparing for their future relationships, family, and children.



**MISSIONS IS EMPHASIZED**

This past Sunday, we were able to have our annual Missions Emphasis Sunday and baptized over 40 newly saved converts from all 6 of our church plants. We were also excited to announce two of our faithful men and their families have surrendered to move and live at two of the locations where we have church plants. Our church family was able to raise over \$4000 for one of our village church's building project. After years of meeting under a mango tree, we were able to upgrade to a tarp and recently God gave us some land and soon we will start building a small structure to have worship services!
