Many of these girls come from broken and difficult backgrounds. Two of them, in particular, had been discarded by their family and tragically trafficked by their own father. **But God's grace is greater.** Through the compassion of one of our church families who adopted them, they've now moved closer to the church and are flourishing in their walk with God.
