Dear Friends,
May 27, 2025

We count it a privilege to remember those who have paid the ultimate price for our freedom in the United States. We are thankful also for the sacrifice that Jesus made, giving his sinless life to pay the price for our sins. May we each be willing to serve and give of ourselves so others may receive “the gift of God which is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”

Our **meeting** schedule is winding down. We reported to three churches in Illinois, preached in a chapel at a Christian school there, and reported to one church in northern Minnesota. We have some supporting churches to visit in North Carolina and then one in South Dakota. We have renewed all necessary passports and are researching our options to return to **Cameroon** towards the middle or end of July.

My trip to **Kenya** in April was successful in many ways. I taught the book of Ezekiel to about ten men, and they all passed the final exam. They are still turning in papers and other projects. I was able to meet and discuss ministry with the college missionary staff who are all involved in church planting around Nairobi. I also met the national pastor from the local church who directs the Bible College there in Nairobi. I really enjoyed my time with the Stephen Rains family at their house as well as serving in their new church plant. I was able to preach about four times while in Kenya and take in my first African safari!

Our **family** has been very busy of late. Our three teenagers attended our church's annual Wisconsin youth conference called Teen Mania. They were also involved in their school *Passion of Christ* play for the Easter outreach. Elena and Elias are both working part time at Chick-fil-A, and Elias hopes to take his driving test soon. Elias passed his FAA Private Pilot written test and started his flying lessons. He hopes to solo within the next month! Elena graduated from high school with honors, and we had a nice open house for her at the Wings As Eagles hangar. At WACS Chloe placed in violin and voice, and Caitlyn placed in spelling, speech, and hand chimes. Caitlyn also celebrated her tenth birthday, while Abby and I took a trip for our twentieth wedding anniversary! We ask you to pray for us as we make this transition to Cameroon. Pray for Elena seeking the Lord's will for her life.

-Pray for final furlough travels and plans to return to Cameroon in July.

-Pray for the health needs of Chris and Laura Sanderlin in France.

-Pray for the crisis to end in the NW and SW regions of Cameroon. One of our pastors is being threatened.

-Pray for Elena as she makes plans for the summer and fall. She had a wonderful graduation!

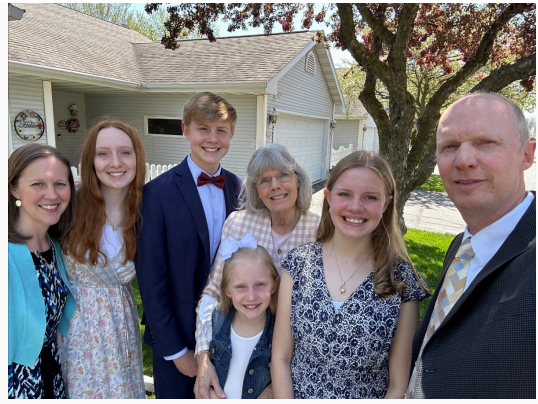
