Dear friends,

We safely arrived in Cameroon on Wednesday night August 13th! The Lord answered your prayers, and we experienced such a smooth journey and arrival. Thank you to Terry Rushing and Chris Sanderlin for taking us to the airport in Chicago and to our friend Theophile for picking us up with a bus and driver in Yaoundé. We had a great night sleep in the capital and a good drive up to Bafoussam the next day. The kids enjoyed reuniting with their dog Daisy, and we got right to work the next few days unpacking and getting our house back in order. Several were sick with respiratory issues, some had jetlag, but we are all doing great today!

We have enjoyed two Sunday services with our friends at Victory Baptist Church and Pastor Olando in Bafoussam. I also enjoyed leading outreaches to the towns of Foubot (by car) and Koutaba (by airplane). Pray for Pastor Bashiru from Babessi who is praying about moving soon to Foubot. Pray for brother Livinus and his family who have been faithful in Koutaba for many years. Pray for the gospel to have free course in these two towns that we have been going to for several years.

Please pray for me as I plan to start flying to Mbakaou every other Sunday. I am also planning to fly out a young man and his family to the Bible institute from Mbakaou. Pray for them to be able to locate housing near the institute and for the Lord to provide for their needs during this big transition.

The aviation ministry is in need of some financial assistance at this time. I plan to fly regularly which comes with its own need of fuel (about \$200 per week). Also there are constant needs of navigation and GPS subscription updates, insurance, overflight permits, inspections, and government required operating certificates. Some of these fees are new and were imposed in the last 4 years, and for which we have not raised extra funds.

I wanted to let you know as well about two personal needs for our family. Abby is in need of a freezer which would allow her greater flexibility for meal prep which is all done from scratch. We also have the opportunity to buy a nice electric piano but lack the funds to do so. The freezer will cost around \$500 and the piano \$800 (or \$900 with a stand).

These are some of the greatest needs we have at this time as we hit the ground running over here! Thank you for praying for our trip, for these needs mentioned, for our spiritual walk with the Lord, for those that we work with, and

for those we share the gospel with.
