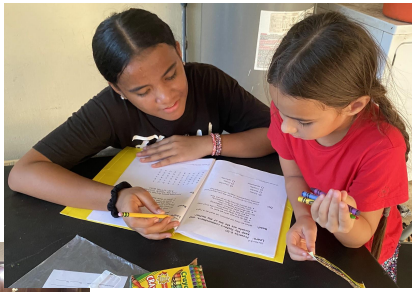
FAMILY
