## Furlough

Thank you for your prayers regarding the timing of our furlough! Our oldest daughter Jesse gave birth to our third grand daughter just 30 hours after we landed in NYC! Gigi was able to be a big part in the delivery, and we are praising God for his goodness. We were able to spend nearly a month with Jesse and her family before heading to KY to pick up William, and then on to Wisconsin and Iowa to visit the rest of the children living stateside.



Although we had to rent two vehicles to drive from NYC to Kentucky, once in KY a church graciously allowed us to borrow their van for the week to drive to WI to visit our children and to attend the annual Victory Conference at Falls Baptist Church. On the last night of services, a pastor from a church we had visited in 2015 asked about our need for a van. He offered his church's shuttle bus to us until we returned to WI in May for Joseph's graduation. This was a huge blessing and answer to prayer!! Once we made it to SC, we were contacted from a supporting church in NC asking us if we had a van yet. I said, "Yes, and no." We have a shuttle bus currently, but we need to return it in May. He then gave us an old van that the church was no longer using! To God be the Glory, great things He hath done! Once again He did "exceedingly abundantly above what we asked or thought!"

We are currently back in Wisconsin. We have been able to attend the junior recital of our daughter, Maggie, and just yesterday the graduation of our son, Joseph. We will remain here until after Joseph's wedding on May 29th. We will then head back to SC for the high school graduation service for our daughter, Noel, on June 10th. We will be in the Pennsylvania area beginning June 14th through early July. Our children will be able to attend summer camp with our home church in July, and after camp, we will be heading toward Iowa, Lord willing, to be there for the birth of our son Revis and his wife Regoice's first baby.



On May 8th, I received a call from a daughter of one of our most faithful men of the church telling me that her dad had just been taken by ambulance to the hospital. It ended up that he had suffered a major stroke and he did not live. As you can imagine, this is very difficult for our family being so far away. Mr. Joe Sanchez was very dear to all of us. I was able to lead him to the Lord in 2020, and he has been faithful and growing ever since.
