Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

A couple of days before Chinese New Year (February 10th), Elena began feeling a lot of pressure in her chest, arms, and at the back of her neck. This lasted for 2 days. She decided to go in to see the doctor just in case, especially as things would be closed for several days during the Chinese New Year holidays. The initial blood tests showed that the level of cardiac enzymes (troponin) was very high in the blood. After a barrage of other tests, including CT scans, an MRI, and a coronary angiogram, **it was discovered that she**

had had a mild heart attack due to a small damaged vessel. She was then kept in the hospital for 5 days for further treatment and observation.

If this sounds familiar, then it probably is because this same thing happened a little



over 8 years ago after our youngest, Ashley, was born! Since this is the second heart attack within a short amount of time, the doctors are giving her long-term medication to take from now on. **Please continue to pray for her as she recovers and that her heart will remain strong. We praise God that Elena went into the hospital when she did, and that it was just a small damaged vessel.**

- Johnson Chiang has been coming faithfully and is very interested in the Bible and church. We have scheduled a weekly Bible study with him.
