Dear Praying Friends,

March 27, 2024

Margie and I thank you for your prayers for us and for the Lord's work in the churches here. We are grateful that Margie's health has greatly improved. Her cardiologist changed her medicine and confirmed yesterday that her arrhythmia has settled down. Her thyroid levels have come back into balance and she has some energy again. After the colonoscopy and a change in diet, her digestive problems are manageable. *So, we thank the Lord and you all for praying for her.*

The Bible institute for the village workers is finishing the first semester. Nine students are completing courses in Personal Evangelism, The Doctrine of God, and The Five Books of Moses. All but one are Sunday school teachers, and two are also deacons. Pray for the Lord to increase their ability to win souls, teach, and lead in the churches.

The village churches continue their activities. Abbe had a missions conference in February and made some efforts in soul-winning, and a new family has been attending. Irfa had a VBS recently, and attendance in the children's ministries has also increased with some new adults. The Donkoi church is to have its missions conference in April. Pastor Jean-Luc is already preparing for the village camp in late July. *Please pray* for these churches to advance toward being self-propagating, self-supporting, and self-governing.

*Pray* for Pastor Romeo's church in south Anyama. A new highway bypass around Abidjan is under construction. The plans call for several buildings near the church to soon be cleared away, including where Romeo's family lives. The church property will not be touched, thank the Lord. *Please pray* as the members have started transforming an annex there into a parsonage. You may recall that Romeo was my partner at the beginning of the Donkoi village church plant.

Now that our health situation is stabilized, Margie and I plan to make a three-month trip to the U.S. from late April into July. One specific need we have is for me to get a better hearing aid. We should be available to report to several churches beginning in May. *Please pray* the Lord to direct our steps in ways we can be useful to Him.
