Margie and I appreciate your prayers for the Lord's work here in our part of Ivory Coast. We continue working with the Fundamental Baptist church plants in the villages of Abbe, Irfa, Donkoi, and Akongokoi around our town of Anyama.

God has been good to bring several believers to a decision to be baptized. On December 29, at the Akongokoi village church work, pastor Jean-Luc baptized Hubert, the village chief. Five were baptized in Donkoi village February 2 : Arsene, a young man, Nadège, a mother of four, Charlene, a young woman, and two teen girls, Mireille and Audrey, who are staying with us in Anyama and going to school nearby. Please pray for their growth in knowing the Lord Jesus.

We have the joy this year of seeing some weddings which are the consolidation of years of youth and church ministry. Donald and Andrea had their engagement ceremony in January and plan to be married April 12 in the church in Irfa village. Regis and Ange were married February 22 and continue in the Irfa church and as Bible institute students. Guillaume and Nadège had their engagement last Saturday and are planning a wedding in August in the Donkoi village church. Please pray for the blessing of the Lord on them as they serve the Lord together.

The Bible institute for the village churches started a new trimester this month with eleven students, including one new, a man named Moise (Moses). Courses include Doctrine of the Church, Pastoral Leadership, Church History, and the Prophets and the Return from Exile. Please pray for them to more fully understand the will of the Lord for their service.

Here are some other subjects of prayer:

1. Several believers in the Abbe village to be baptized at Paques (french for Passover).
2. The Round Robin missions conference coming up in Abbe, Irfa and Donkoi villages.
