Dear Praying Friends,

March 26, 2026

Margie and I thank you for praying for the Lord's work in the fundamental Baptist churches in Anyama and the villages outside of town. We rejoice in professions of faith in Christ that resulted in two baptisms on Sunday, March 1. Mikael is the head teacher at the public school in Donkoi village. Emmanuella is a single woman reached by visits to a nearby plantation from the Irfa village church. Please pray for them to grow in Christ and be used of God to win others.

On March 14, Jires, a young member of the Donkoi church, and Grace were married in her Baptist church in the city of Abidjan. The couple came the next day to Donkoi for the service and a reception in their honor. Pray for this new household to be a godly example to others.

On Saturday, March 21, the ladies of the Donkoi, Irfa, and Abbe churches had a meeting to learn about being a "useful woman" from Proverbs 31. Three ladies came for the first time. Jean-Luc's wife, Viviane, and Bob did the teaching. Please pray for these ladies to follow God's plan.

Please pray for good fruit from the missions conference taking place as I write this at the Abbe church. National missionary Daniel Barou, who was sent out by the Anyama church to develop a church work in the city of Abengourou, is the guest speaker. Pray also for some new people in Abbe who have been coming frequently to publicly confess Christ and be baptized: Gertrude, Ramos, his sister Priscillia, Carlos and his girlfriend, and for Mambo, the wife of church member Koné. Please also pray for Jacques, an Abbe member who is backsliding and drinking.

The Bible institute continues, meeting in the Abbe village church, with nine of the eleven students showing growth. Please pray for them as we hope to graduate several of them this summer.

Pray for some building projects to be useful for the Lord: at Donkoi, electrical service was installed last week, so they can use the building in the evenings. Next week, a carpenter from the Anyama church is to replace the leaky roofs on the two Donkoi Sunday school rooms. At Abbe, the men of the church have done the digging for a septic tank for the church. They hope to have electrical service in the Abbe church in the next month. At Irfa, a tall tree was blown down against a corner of the church building. Pastor Jean-Luc has the members working on a solution. Thank you!
