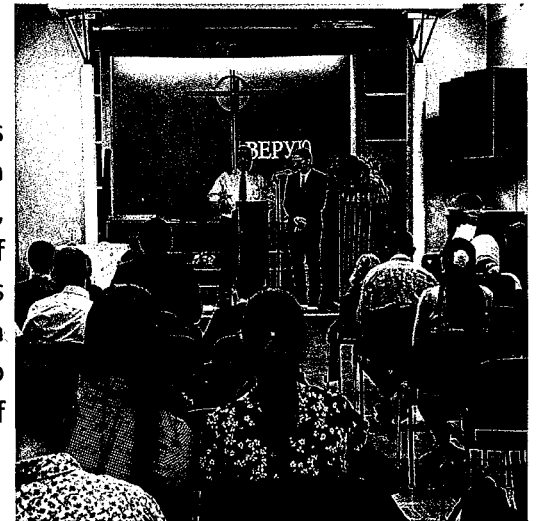
Youth & Family Camp
