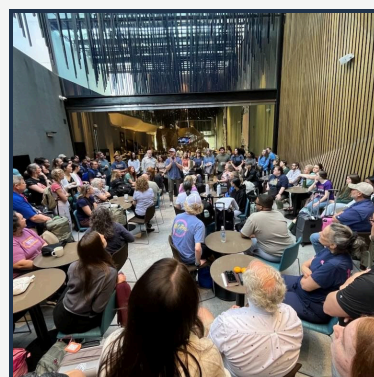
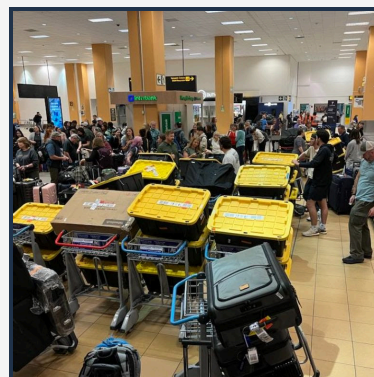
“For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works.”

Peru

It was quite a scene as we landed in Peru with 111 team members and over 150 pieces of luggage! We gathered with great anticipation of what God would do in the following days. As our teams split into the three different cities where we would serve, the work began. I was with the team in Lima and was so proud of how they served. We were able to offer a variety of clinics all under the roof of a spacious school building and in partnership with a local church.

In Lima we provided medical, optical, dental, physical therapy, and soul care. I was able to witness the joy on the faces of so many patients who received the care they had long waited for. Our Soul Care clinic did deep work through heavy conversations that resulted in healing, forgiveness, and freedom. Our team proved their commitment to serve as we experienced commutes of 2-3 hours each way to the clinic due to the traffic in Lima. Our bodies were tired but our souls were full as we finished our clinic in Lima.



Honduras

Last week I was able to take a quick trip to Honduras to visit our surgical center. This trip allowed me to work on some needed repairs and spend time with our local partners to plan some upcoming projects to keep our building in good shape for the surgical teams. Our most recent surgical team provided 32 surgical procedures. While I've never been in the operating room during surgery, it is a joy to have a part in preparing and preserving our building to be used to impact lives in this community.
