The church we started here in Zacatecas celebrated its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary last month. We had a really good group of people with six first time visitors. There were also three people that were saved that day! The people sang a bunch of special songs and the spirit was great! After the morning services we had a delicious meal and cake! Roberto invited a neighbor of his to come to church and she came and got saved! A few weeks later she invited us to her house to give her family a Bible study. She wants her family to understand about how to be saved.

Lidia invited a group of ten girls from the Pozo church to the house to bake cookies. They jumped on the trampoline and played basketball as well as making chocolate chip cookies. They very much enjoyed the time together and in the end they did not want to go back home! These children just need someone to care about them and show them interest. You never know what God has planned in their lives.

We celebrated Lidia's 29<sup>th</sup> birthday in the church! This is one of her many 29<sup>th</sup> birthdays! We had food and activities that Sunday. We had some of church people help with the work of decorating the church. This also was a blessed time.

About 15 years ago we lived in a rented house and we had some very catholic neighbors across the street. They played loud music and we did not like the way things were going. So Lidia made them cookies and brought them over to their house. Things began to change for the better and we have known them for many years. They came to Abi's going away party at the church but they were very uncomfortable because of where we had it. We have not been in contact with them very much over the years but as of late it seems they are searching for the truth. We have given them the Gospel but the man is hardened. His wife seems ready to hear and believe but she stays quiet because that is the style here in Mexico. Lidia talked to them today and he is asking questions. He does not believe but just the fact that he is asking is a big deal. Please pray for Patro and his wife Yuri to be saved.

Since our last letter Lidia and I have seen 18 people saved and our church people led another 15 people to Christ! A young man named Armando returned to church after being gone many years. In Pozo, Christian's mom was taken away by the bad people and no one knows where she is at. A few weeks ago Luz Maria's grandson was killed where he worked. It is believed that the bad people got him. This is now a very common thing here. Please pray for safety and for God's will to be done.
