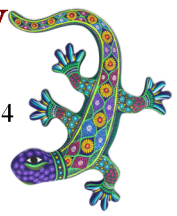

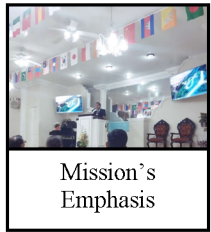
Dear Praying Friends,
