We invite you to rejoice with us for the blessings bestowed upon our ministry. Since our last letter, dozens have been saved in our churches. Many visitors have come to attend. We have installed provisional lighting in our second church, and we have witnessed God's healing power in the life of one of our men! May Christ be magnified!

I had mentioned one of our church men Diego Hernandez in a previous letter. Diego is a Bible college graduate and plans to start a church. However, he was plagued with reflux problems and went for reflux surgery here in our city. Sadly, there were complications during the procedure, and Diego went into respiratory arrest during the surgery. With the lack of oxygen, he came out of the operating room in a comatose state with brain injury.
