DAILY FEEDING IN THE DUMP

Walk through the landfill community and you'll see—nothing has changed. The same haunting images: children half-clothed, bones showing through fragile skin, eyes tired far too early in life. Our Children's Home has provided refuge to some, but far too many are still left behind. That's why, in 2025, God impressed upon our hearts to launch a community-based extension of the Home.

We began with what we had—ten children. Children who came from our Saturday feeding ministry. Children God led to us. Each day, they are welcomed in, given a warm bath, fresh clothes, a nourishing meal, and most importantly, time in God's Word and foundational literacy skills.

But then others came. Hungry for food, yes—but even more for love, stability, and the hope only Jesus can give. We simply couldn't turn them away. Today, twenty children walk through our doors daily. Our hearts are full, even if our hands are stretched.

Our aim goes beyond physical relief. We dream of raising up sons and daughters of the King—children who will grow to love and serve our Master despite their beginnings. The younger ones attend our Saturday feeding ministry and Sunday children's church. The older ones are already learning to serve, assisting in ministry and showing signs of spiritual maturity.

Let me share one story—Jake Cyrus. Left in the care of his aging grandparents after his mother, Mary Jane, disappeared into the darkness of prostitution at just 12 years old. We knew Mary Jane. She was one of ours. Once a child in our ministry herself, she strayed and got swallowed by the same system we're now fighting. But today, her son Jake is with us. And we are praying—desperately—that his story ends differently.

Please lift this ministry in your prayers. There is so much more to be done.



3,000 KIDS IN VBS

This May, we will once again host our annual Vacation Bible School across various locations in the landfill community. Our goal? To reach 3,000 children with the gospel.

For two decades now, God has used this ministry to transform lives. Many children saved through VBS are now pastors, teachers, faithful lay workers in the harvest field.
