One night at three in the morning, JAYLAN called one of our Bible Basketball coaches in fear because his father had come home in a drunken rage. A violent fight broke out between his parents, leaving his mother with cuts on her neck. Naturally, the children were deeply traumatized by what they witnessed. Our coach prayed with JAYLAN over the phone and continued to stay in close contact with the family in the days that followed. Because of the situation, JAYLAN's mother initially planned to move the children to another province for safety. However, through much prayer and encouragement, she found the courage to report the situation to the authorities. As a result, the father was forced to leave the area. By God's grace, JAYLAN and his family are now safe. We appreciate your continued prayers for JAYLAN and his family as they recover from this difficult situation.
