Dear Praying Friends,

October was another busy month. Thankfully, after four months of delays, the container for the Philippines was finally loaded and the Word of God is headed to the mission field. Bro. Sam Martin of World Missions Bearing Precious Seed, who manages these for us, informed me that he has switched to a Filipino based trucking company. Hopefully, they can help us better with timing on the containers. We understand that it is based on container availability. We have learned that if we order both a 20 foot as well as a 40-foot container at the same time and take whichever one is available, it should help us to get one. This container to Manilla was a 40-foot container which meant it could hold more Scriptures. There were 1,447 cases of Scripture loaded totaling 335,570 English John and Romans with a specialized cover for the Philippines. There were also 120 whole leather Bibles for Pastors.

We were supposed to have loaded another container to a different island in the Philippines at the end of October, but it has been pushed back to mid-November. Please be in prayer that we do not experience the same delays as before. We also have a container to be loaded and sent to our main distribution center in Bangkok, Thailand, in mid-November as well. In Thailand, flooding in parts of the country became an issue this past month. Tan worked diligently to get Scriptures moved to other parts of the country to keep them safe. This created an extra expense that we did not anticipate, please pray that the Lord will re-supply the funds that were used for the extra trucking costs.

Amber and I started out the month still in Maine with meetings there. I was honored to preach at a community wide harvest party in Liberty, Maine, on Saturday, October 1st. Please pray for the Gospel seed that was planted in many hearts. We enjoyed time with South Liberty Baptist in Liberty, ME, and look forward to being back with them next year. From Maine, we flew to Atlanta for meetings in Georgia, Tennessee, and Alabama. From there we drove down to Florida for meetings and while there we were also able to enjoy a few days of rest and relaxation with most of our kids and grandkids. I was blessed to be able to squeeze in a couple of rounds of golf with two of my sons in laws.

I told you last month about the Bible translation work that is being done for a creative access nation language. Lord willing, we will be looking to start the print production of this mid-2023. It will be a project that will cost around \$100,000. Cane Creek Baptist Church in Etowah, TN, has given the first \$5,000 towards this. Praise the Lord! To my knowledge this will be the first time this language has had a whole Bible in their native tongue. Pray with us about the funds for this, as well as the work involved to get these Scriptures into this country.
