We started the month finishing up a Missions Conference in Illinois. The Lord protected us from a massive pile up on I-55 as we traveled south to our next meeting. We will get the opportunity to have a hand in unloading the material as well as handing out the material.

We hosted our 2nd Annual Midwest Regional BEST Missions Bible Conference May 7-9 at Landmark Baptist Church in Evansville, IN. There was a good turnout of not just lay people but also area Pastors and a few missionaries for it. All total we had at least 13 preachers that I remember plus a tour group from Hyles Anderson College. Everyone had the opportunity to help assemble some Tamil John and Romans for India during the afternoon part of the conference. There were also several thousand dollars given to help produce more Scripture. One of the young men in the tour group said to me that he had never been to a meeting like it. Several of the Pastors responded with saying that The Lord had worked on their hearts about doing more to help their missionaries with Scripture.

Our third daughter Aleah married Andrew Kirves on May 26th. We were able to be with all four of our daughters and their husbands along with our five grandchildren (soon to be six), as well as with many of our friends and family for the beautiful wedding ceremony. Thank you to all who prayed for us and to the friends and family who helped with the wedding.

Amber and I head to Thailand on June 5th. As I mentioned, we are going to be hosting the Ogles not just in Thailand, but we are going to travel to two other countries that are more creative access nations. There will be added costs of around \$2,000.00 for these trips including three more international flights. We will be able to meet some of the Pastors who have been working on the creative access language Bible project we have been promoting. If you can help us with the extra expenses, it would be a help to us, especially after paying for a wedding.
