The Sunday after Thanksgiving I was able to give a report and preach for the church I use to pastor before stepping out by faith into missions with BEST Missions. It was great to see former parishioners and great to see how God has blessed with many new faces. Maranatha Baptist in Newburgh will always have a special place in our heart, and we appreciate them very much.

Please pray as Tuesday, December fifth, we will be loading our 41st container of Scripture from Colonial Baptist Church in Rogers, AR. Loading is scheduled to start at 8am.
