Dear Praying Friends,

What the Lord did during our BEST Conference this year exceeded our prayers and what we envisioned! We had been praying for \$50,000 to help with the next printing of 5,000 whole Bibles. \$63,000 would allow us to print 8,000 whole Bibles. The offering from the conference was a little over \$78,000. We are working to get 8,000 Thai Bibles printed as I write this. World Missions BPS is also donating 1,000 whole English Bibles. The Yoruba Bible Project in Nigeria has been completed and delivered to the Yoruba speaking churches. The Miskito Bible project has been delivered in Honduras. We are also coordinating with some national Pastors in a couple of creative access countries in Southeast Asia to get some Bibles to them. I am trying to coordinate with a missionary in Serbia to help him get some more Serbian New Testaments.

Once the Thai Whole Bible project is complete, we will be working to do another printing of the Thai Soul Winners New Testament along with some Thai Soul Winning Notebooks. World Missions BPS and Faith Scripture Printing are working away on the paper Thai New Testaments as well as another half a million Thai John and Romans for us. Our 43rd container of Scripture should arrive in Bangkok toward the end of October. We are working to schedule our next container to be shipped out from Colonial Baptist Church in Rogers, AR, around the second week of December.

September is usually one of our busiest months and this past month was no different. Amber and I had meetings from Arkansas to Oklahoma to North Dakota to Georgia to Maine and lastly in Quebec, Canada. We were a part of two different mission conferences, one missions Sunday, closed out a meeting at a Bible college that was emphasizing the 10/40 window, reported to a couple supporting churches and was able to present BEST Missions to two new churches.

Thank you to every individual, and every church that have given to help us get more Scriptures not only printed and delivered, but also distributed. You can't plant seed in the barn! Thank you to those who have given to help us with the purchase of a newer vehicle to keep us on the road. I pick up the car on the ninth of October.

Thank you to those who pray for us and BEST Missions regularly.
