Unfortunately, Uganda does not get to experience the beautiful color change of the leaves, nor does it have any chance of witnessing a “white Christmas.” With great expectations, we have been anticipating the cooler weather of fall and winter in the United States!

During the month of October, we had four new churches financially partner with us and our ministry in Uganda! In addition to visiting churches, we were able to spend some time with my aunt and uncle in McDonough, GA, and an extended amount of time with my sister and grandparents in Powell, TN. Abbey and I are very thankful to have many of our family members faithfully attending church and serving in various ministries. Please continue to pray for my youngest sister, Emma, that God would guide her steps as she completes her junior of Bible college.

I would also ask for specific prayer on behalf of one of our supporting churches, Greater Vancouver Baptist Church. Their pastor of over thirty-five years, Pastor Gordon Conner, passed away last month after battling several health difficulties. Please pray for Mrs. Conner, their children, and their grandchildren that God would continue to give them grace and peace during this time of transition. Pastor Conner had a tremendous impact all throughout my life. His passion for reaching the youth of British Columbia reverberated around the entire country of Canada. On November 20th, she has a full anatomy scan of the baby scheduled which will also reveal the gender.
- 4. More People to Surrender to Worldwide Missions.** While the need for more laborers in North America is still very great, we also need more laborers to surrender to be used of God around the world.
