- 3. Madelyn's development.** In preparation for our move back to Uganda, we are praying that Madelyn's immune system will be strengthened before being introduced to the challenges of living in a third world country.
- 4. The future church plant in Fort Portal.** Our prayer is that God would open the necessary doors, prepare the hearts of the people, and give us wisdom as we embark on our first church plant later this year.
- 5. More people to surrender to worldwide missions.** While the need for more laborers in North America is still great, we also need more laborers to surrender to be used of God around the world.
