July 2025

Our furlough/extended stay for the birth of Madelyn has officially come to end! We arrived back in Entebbe, Uganda on July 16th and have been doing our best to get adjusted to the time difference. Thankfully, Uganda is in a rainy season right now; so, the temperatures are much cooler and more bearable. As we were checking in at the Delta Airlines desk in Indianapolis, the attendant alerted us of a travel embargo with Delta that limited our family to four checked bags per person. Unfortunately, we were not aware of this and had prepared twenty-eight bags to be checked. This was an extreme disappointment, but we are grateful that our family was there to assist us. Please pray for a safe arrival of the remaining twelve boxes that began the long journey from Indiana to Uganda via FedEx on the 22nd.

Since last May, we traveled over 30,000 miles on roads and another 15,000+ miles by air. Seventy-three churches allowed us to bring an update or present our ministry. The Lord truly blessed our travels in which we saw people saved, talked to many young people who expressed a desire to serve the Lord in missions, and partnered with several new churches to reach people with the Gospel in Uganda.

We would not have had the safety or strength for furlough without the faithful prayers of God's people. In June, we visited our sending church, Anchor Baptist Church, and enjoyed a wonderful time of family and fellowship with my parents and the members of ABC. I am very grateful for my upbringing and the faithfulness that has been exuded in the lives of the people from my home church. God has blessed my parents and used their willingness to serve God to see much accomplished for the cause of Christ!

While awaiting our return to Uganda, we had the opportunity to attend Abbey's home church, Greenwood Bible Baptist, at which Carson was able to attend SS consistently and participate in their annual VBS. On July 13th, the church had a "going-away" service in which many of the members came forward and prayed over us. It was both an emotional and encouraging time as we listened to the powerful prayers of many men, women, teens and children.

Please pray for the following requests in the month of July:

- 1. Adapting to Uganda.** It is always challenging for our bodies to get adjusted to the time difference, the food, the weather, and the air quality.
- 2. My father's health.** Please continue to keep my dad, Pastor Ben Turner, in your prayers. He is still dealing with neuropathy in both legs and feet and needs miracle healing from the Lord!
- 3. Madelyn's development.** She is now four months old! Please pray that her young immune system will be able to handle the potential dangers that are present in the Pearl of Africa.
- 4. The future church plant in Fort Portal.** Our prayer is that God would open the necessary doors, prepare the hearts of the people, and give us wisdom as we embark on our first church plant.
- 5. More people to surrender to worldwide missions.** While the need for more laborers in North America is still great, we also need more laborers to surrender to be used of God around the world.
