Dear Pastor and praying friends:

We want to praise the Lord for The mighty work that He is doing here in the City of Chipata; as stated in our last letter, we had our Charter Service on the 19th of November. We saw 125 in attendance, of which 15 were first-time visitors, 15 people followed the Lord in Believers Baptism, and we had a wonderful time of food and fellowship to finish the day.

One of those who followed the Lord in baptism has been a great blessing to me, Joe, who is 16 years old. He started coming to church on his own about four months ago. When he learned about Saturday Evangelism, he asked if he could participate. He came, and afterward, I asked him if he had received Salvation; he thought he had because he was doing good work and trying to keep the law. I opened the Bible and showed him that Salvation comes only by faith in the Grace God offers freely; he chose to put his faith in Christ that day and receive that gift. We went and visited his mother (unfortunately, his father is not in the picture) to get permission to Baptize him. His mother was so surprised that a church would take such interest in a “Boy,” but she was glad he chose to follow Christ on his own. She permitted him to be baptized, and since then, Joe has been bringing his three younger brothers to church with him.

Lorin teaches the Children’s church every Sunday; when she started a year ago with this ministry, there were only ten children; now, she is teaching, on average, 40 children every week, ages five months up to 11. She does have help from a rotation of women in the church, and it is a blessing to see these ladies wanting to serve the Lord.

Please be in prayer for Chiyembekezo Mpingo Wa Baptist; this is the church out in the village. We have recently gone through some struggles at the church with some members and have had some serious conversations with them about the danger of sowing discord among the brethren. They seemed receptive to the meeting, but prayer is needed for this church to grow spiritually and remain faithful to the Lord.

Thank you all for your continued support, prayers, and Love. We would not be able to go first without the Lord and second without all of you.
