Dear Pastor and praying friends:

The Celebration of Christ's Resurrection was a wonderful time, and we hope you also had a blessed time. We spent the Sunday School hour focusing on the Blood that Christ shed for us and its significance, as well as the importance of His body being broken for us. The Children's Choir sang, as did some other specials by the Matacchiera family. The morning service concluded with a message on Christ's victory over Sin and Death. Please pray for Hope Bible Baptist Church. We have had to deal with an individual within the church who was secretly living in sin and affecting others because of these sins. Pray that God will give us wisdom in guiding and directing the church and helping those affected so that we all bring honor and glory to God through it all and that the church will grow.

We recently shipped 2 barrels from the States with the children's school for next year and other things. They were scheduled to be shipped out of Baltimore, but with the collapse of the Francis Scott Key Bridge, they have been delayed as they try to reroute them to another port for shipping. Pray they are timely enough so that the kids can start school on time next year.

We thank all who prayed for rain here. Some rain did come, which was a blessing, but unfortunately, it was too little too late, and the harvest this year will be very meager. Please continue to pray for God's provision for the people and for their reliance on God to provide. Often, the people here will look to NGOs and foreigners as their providers because they have become conditioned that they can just wait for handouts. We want them to realize the truth of Matthew 6:31-33, that they can rely on God to provide for them.

The quarterly Bible School at Chiyembekezo Mpingo wa Baptist went very well; we had 31 men in attendance as we taught lessons based on the Theme from Matthew 7:16, "Real Fruit." There were six lessons:

- Real Zeal is born from knowledge (Rom 10:1-4).
- Real Faith produces Works (James 2:14-18).
- Real Churches produce Disciples (Matt 28:19-20).
- Real Love produces Obedience (John 14:15-21).
- Real Godliness produces Power (2 Timothy 3:1-7).
- Real Prayer produces Peace (Phil 4:6-7).

These topics were very eye-opening for many of these men, as they had had their ideas about these topics twisted by many other churches' teaching traditions instead of the Bible.
