Dear Pastor and praying friends:

Over the last nine weeks, God has been doing work in Katete, and we have averaged a total attendance of 90. Of those in attendance, the children's ministry is averaging 80; Lorin is quite busy, as I am sure you can imagine. They meet in the front yard on grass mats under some trees; she has been teaching through the days of Creation and is amazed at the complete absence of any knowledge that most of the children have about how the World came to be. On the positive side, they don't even know about Evolution. Please pray that these children will come to know the God who created all things as their Savior and Lord.

Meanwhile, in the house where I am teaching adults about baptism and how it is not what saves us, but Christ and His shed blood that offer us His Grace through Faith. The Old Testament does not mention the word 'baptism.' Still, we know that Peter and Paul both reference baptism as a figure found in the story of Noah and the Ark, as well as Moses crossing the Red Sea with the Israelites. The people are amazed to see that the water killed those who did not follow God by faith in each story. We will soon be moving on to the topic of what the Bible says about "Faith." Going over each of these topics is crucial, as these individuals possess a lot of information in their minds based on what the churches are saying rather than what the Bible says. Please pray for these adults that the Seed of the Word of God will find Good Soil so that they will find Faith in Christ as their Savior.

I was recently invited to preach at a Youth Camp for Independent Baptist Churches in the Villages of the Eastern Province, approximately 2 hours from our ministry in Katete. I preached twice; the first message was about what it means to have "True Religion" verse "Someone who seems to be religious." Fifty-six young people came forward after the service and made decisions to trust Christ as their Savior. The following message was about "Keeping oneself unspotted from the World." The Youth Leaders later told me that they could see the message making sense in the minds of the youth as I used an illustration of having a White Shirt on and every time the person decided to sin, I would take paint and mark up the shirt, making the White shirt dirty and no longer clean. Pray that these young people, who have made a decision for Christ, will continue to follow Christ in their lives.
